- Alisha Campbell from the Department of Health
  - Data on drug overdoses.
  - Fentanyl section will be added to the next data. • Naloxone data.
- Erika Abeyta from the Department of Health:
  - What community partners are doing.
  - What to address.
  - Drug overdose: assessment, prevention, educational planning, and action component.
  - Training for Naloxone.
  - MAT needs.
  - Report progress and evaluation.
- Jessica Garcia and Summer Lileck from the UP! Coalition:
  - Provide prevention efforts in Dona Ana County.
  - Work with clients for alcohol, tobacco, and other substances.
  - Harm reduction.
  - Narcan training scheduled for Dona Ana County is June 27, 2022.
  - Fentanyl strips are upcoming.
  - Substances go by various names and emojis.
  - Program for parents - Talk: They Hear You. Open, honest communication and dialogue as the child ages.

  - MAT for Fentanyl and other substances.
  - No waiting list.
  - Outpatient treatment.
  - Medicaid accepted.
  - Nonjudgemental.

- MAT with psychosocial treatment.
  - Treatment protocols.
  - Age 14 and up for opioids.
  - Switch from substance to medication.
- Kristin Drake from Peak Behavioral Health
    - Inpatient treatment for Fentanyl, alcohol, and other substances.
    - Naltrexone is being used for Fentanyl and alcohol treatment.
    - Partial hospitalization 8:30 AM - 1:30 PM.
    - PHP and ACT only used for symptoms of withdrawal.
    - 3rd judicial court contract.
    - Increasing Fentanyl use in youth.
